<b>REGULATIONS</b>	<p><b>As per the Gymnastics Ontario Technical Rules and Regulations Manual and competition manuals.</b></p> <p><b>Competition Format:</b> OCP Warm Up</p> <p><b>Scoring Program:</b> KSIS (<a href="http://ksis.eu/resultx.php?id_prop=6969">http://ksis.eu/resultx.php?id_prop=6969</a>)</p> <p><b>Music:</b> <i>Level 1-5:</i> Floor compulsory music will be provided by the host club. <i>Xcel:</i> Floor music must be uploaded to KSIS no later than <b>Dec. 15, 2024</b>. Clubs responsible for <i>backup music</i> (mp3 format). Music files should be clearly named and identified with the club name (shortened or acronym), level and full name of the athlete, for example: CLUB_XcelBronze_FirstName_LastName.</p> <p><b>MIX IT UP:</b> <b>ONLY at ASF: OCP 9+ Athletes will be mixed with other clubs to form a unique and exciting team competition with great awards!!</b></p> <p><b>Awards:</b> For <b>Events</b> and <b>All Around:</b> 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> Medals, 4<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> Ribbons (all ages). No Bumping of places for ties. Small groups for awards.  <b>Every session: Special awards for events</b> (individual trophies) AND <b>top mixed-team award</b> (1st, 2nd, and 3rd place awards)!!  <b>Outstanding club team spirit awards</b> (club trophy or plaque, per day). <b>EQUIPMENT</b>	<p>Spieth America (1 set of equipment) <b>Vault runway length 24 m.</b> <b>Floor is close to wall.</b> <b>Low ceiling (15 ft) makes handstand on high bar difficult for taller athletes.</b></p>	
<b>CODE OF CONDUCT</b>	<p><b>Aggressive behaviour is not accepted and will not be tolerated.</b> Anyone displaying aggressive or disruptive behaviour, or refusing to adhere to health and safety guidelines, will be asked to <b>leave the premises</b>. If warranted, the police will be contacted.</p>

**COACH REQUIREMENTS**

**Coaches must:**

- be registered with Gymnastics Ontario for membership
- registered in KSIS,
- be present with athletes on-site
- bring and show their GO Coaching ID provided by Gymnastics Ontario to the competition showing they have up-to-date NCCP requirements for the level of athlete participating to gain access to the competition floor (field of play).

It is the club’s and individual coach’s responsibility to ensure they have the correct certifications and coaching ID for competition.

Provincial Coaches: must be NCCP Competition 1 (Introduction) Trained, MED, Safe Sport and up to date Risk Management certification (Respect in Sport) to be eligible for the competition floor.

National Coaches: must be minimum NCCP Competition 2 (Intro Advanced) Trained in addition to the provincial coach requirements to be eligible for the competition floor.

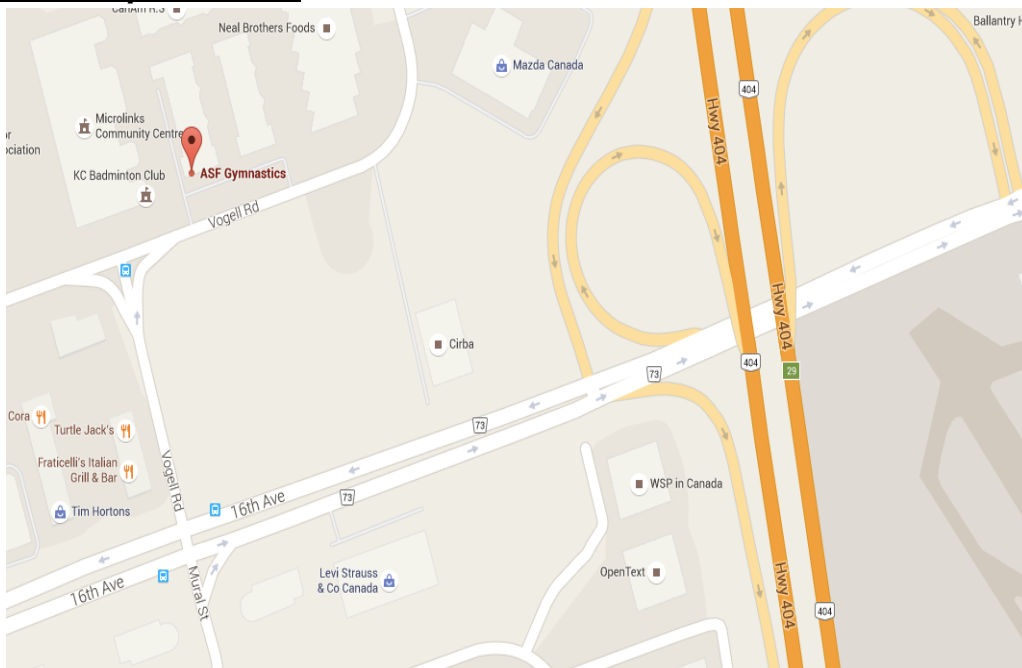

Take 404 North to 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue. From interchange, take a right (west) onto 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue West (right). At the second traffic light, take a right onto Vogell Road going north. At the stop sign, veer to the right to stay on Vogell Rd. Venue located at 2<sup>nd</sup> driveway on left (building 40, unit #32).
