

Music files should be clearly named and identified with the club name (shortened or acronym), level and full name of the athlete, for example: CLUB_XcelBronze_FirstName_LastName. Awards: For **Events** and **All Around**: 1st to 3rd Medals, 4th to 10th Ribbons (all ages). No Bumping of places for ties. Small groups for awards. Every session: Special awards for events (individual trophies) AND a team **spirit award** (club trophy or plaque) Top team awards for 1st, 2nd, 3rd place club (large column trophies) based on all-weekend top scores. Fun athlete gifts for all participants. **Coaches:** Coaches will be treated to healthy food options and beverages. Please inform host club with dietary restrictions. Coaches' draw every session.
