

COACH REQUIREMENTS	Coaches must: - be registered with Gymnastics Ontario for membership - registered in KSIS, - be present with athletes on-site - bring and show their GO Coaching ID provided by Gymnastics Ontario to the competition showing they have up-to-date NCCP requirements for the level of athlete participating to gain access to the competition floor (field of play).						
	It is the club's and individual coach's responsibility to ensure they have the correct certifications and coaching ID for competition.
