<b>REGULATIONS</b>	<p><b>As per the Gymnastics Ontario Technical Rules and Regulations Manual and competition manuals.</b></p> <p><b>Competition Format:</b> OCP Warm Up</p> <p><b>Scoring Program:</b> KSIS</p> <p><b>Music:</b> Music must be submitted via KSIS as part of each athlete's competition registration for Xcel and Optional athletes. All files must be clearly labeled with the athlete's name, club and level. A back up copy may be submitted by usb drive or Mp3 device. Compulsory music will be provided by the host club</p> <p><b>Awards:</b> Medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place (no bumping for ties); ribbons for 4th-10th place. Special Judges award for each event.</p>
<b>LEVELS AND AGES</b>	ODP ages 6-9yrs, Xcel Bronze, Silver and Gold ages 7yrs +, Level 1-9 Ages 7yrs+


<b>REGISTRATION</b>	<p>All athletes and coaches must be registered with G.O for the 2024-2025 season</p> <p><b>Registration Deadline:</b> Saturday November 16th 2024</p> <p><b>Fees:</b> ODP: \$90 plus HST, OCP: \$110 plus HST</p> <p><b>Method of Payment:</b> Club cheque or e-transfer to info@gymfinity.ca</p> <p><b>Level Changes:</b> Level changes can be submitted up to December 21st 2024</p> <p><b>Refunds Policy:</b> <u>No Refunds</u> will be issued for withdraw after the registration deadline of November 16th 2024</p>
<b>EQUIPMENT</b>	<p>1 full set of equipment. All competition equipment is SA Sport and to GO Specification. There is a small pole located on the floor approximately 2ft in from the white line (central to the floor and not conflicting with either diagonal for tumbling. There will be a variety of soft, medium and hard spring boards on site.</p>

<b>COACH REQUIREMENTS</b>	<p><b>Coaches must:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- be registered with Gymnastics Ontario for membership</li> <li>- registered in KSIS,</li> <li>- be present with athletes on-site</li> <li>- bring and show their GO Coaching ID provided by Gymnastics Ontario to the competition showing they have up-to-date NCCP requirements for the level of athlete participating to gain access to the competition floor (field of play).</li> </ul> <p>It is the club's and individual coach's responsibility to ensure they have the correct certifications and coaching ID for competition.</p> <p>Please see coaching requirements for floor access:  <a href="http://www.gymnasticsontario.ca/coaching-requirements/">http://www.gymnasticsontario.ca/coaching-requirements/</a></p> <p>Provincial Coaches: must be NCCP Competition 1 (Introduction) Trained, MED, Safe Sport and up to date Risk Management certification (Respect in Sport) to be eligible for the competition floor.</p>
